Our values

Global Health 2030 is a non-profit association under the law of 1901. Through our actions, we propose recommendations in the field of global health. We share the essence of our work via our website and social networks to a wide audience. Our objective is to contribute to the improvement of French global health policy through various means:

- proposing analyses and operational recommendations
- mobilising a network of high-level experts
- discussing with decision-makers
- promoting our ideas as widely as possible
- animating democratic debate and deliberation

Our values are as follows:

Demanding, rigour and integrity: The demand for quality and rigour is at the heart of our action. Our proposals combine the solidity of science, realism and the search for universal access to health care.

Openness and diversity: We bring together multiple profiles and sensibilities. Researchers, field actors, journalists, representatives of the private for-profit sector or the associative world, French or international, take part in our work in the framework of our working groups, hearings or public meetings. Each member of the think tank fills in a declaration of interest every year.

Respect for others. We consider that recognition of the contribution of each individual is essential, as is the fight against all forms of discrimination, whether racial, social, gender or related to sexual orientation.

Independence: Our political and intellectual independence is complete. In particular, the think tank does not depend on any political party and sets its own agenda and objectives.

Any member of the group, or personality associated with our work, commits to respect this charter. In the event of proven non-compliance, the think tank may go so far as to exclude one of its members.
